

Introduction

This policy outlines how ExValue Trading BV ("ExValue") handles personal information collected on its website exval.io ("Website"). It does not cover information collected through other channels.

Collected Information

Personal Information

ExValue may gather personal details such as your name, address, and email, along with any other information you provide, for instance, via forms or documents submitted during your website visit.

Non-Personal Information

ExValue may also collect non-personal data about your visits, including:

- IP address and domain name used
- Browser type and operating system
- Date, time, and duration of visits
- Number of visits and referral sources

To collect some of this information, ExValue uses tracking tools like browser cookies. Third-party analytics services, such as Google Analytics, may also use cookies to provide insights into your website interactions.

Lawful Basis for Processing

ExValue processes personal data based on the following legal grounds under GDPR:

- Consent: When you provide explicit consent.
- Contractual Necessity: To fulfill contractual obligations.
- Legal Obligation: To comply with legal requirements.
- Legitimate Interests: For purposes such as improving services, provided these do not override your rights.

Use of Collected Data

ExValue uses the information it collects to:

- Communication and recruitment
- Enhance security
- Improve the Website

Data Sharing

ExValue may share your data with employees, agents, or third-party service providers who need this information to perform their duties, respond to requests, comply with legal requirements, or investigate potential fraud. All data sharing is

conducted in compliance with GDPR requirements, ensuring adequate protection of your personal data.

Data Protection and Retention

ExValue is committed to safeguarding personal data against unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure data security. Personal data is retained only as long as necessary for the purposes described or as required by the EU law. Your data will be kept in EU servers.

Your Rights Under GDPR
